I. LOGISTICS:

PLAN COLOMBIA: ALL EQUIPMENT FOR THE 2D BACNA ARRIVED TO CALI VIA C-17 AS SCHEDULED ON 8 DECEMBER. TALCE TEAM, GIL WOLMERS AND SOC LNO ELEMENT RECEIVED AND TRANSLOADED ALL 17 PALLETS. TRANSLOAD TO MC 130 FOR DELIVERY TO LARANDIA WENT EXTREMELY WELL. (b)(3)-10 USC ASSETS DELIVERED ALL 17 PALLETS BETWEEN 8-10 DEC 00. COMPLETE JOINT INVENTORY ACCOMPLISHED BETWEEN SC J4/SC J36/USMILGP/CN BRIGADE REPS. CN BDE DOES NOT PLAN TO ISSUE BACNA 2 EQUIPMENT UNTIL 3 JAN 01 TO PREVENT LOSS AND PILFERAGE DURING CHRISTMAS BREAK. ADDITIONALLY, SOME ITEMS ARE NOT REGULAR ISSUE TO THE SOLDIERS AND COLAR WANTS TO PROVIDE TRAINING ON CARE AND USE OF EQUIPMENT.

COLAR UH-60LS: REQUISITIONS FOR SUPPORT ITEMS WERE CUT AT USASAC. SOME ITEMS HAVE ALREADY BEEN SHIPPED AND WE EXPECT THEM IN-COUNTRY BY THE END OF THE YEAR. A COORDINATED EFFORT BETWEEN CHARLESTON AFB, USMILGP, COLOMBIAN ARMY EXTERIOR COMMERCE DEPT, AND COLOMBIAN ARMY AVIATION IS REQUIRED TO ENSURE ELEMENTS ARE SEGREGATED FROM REGULAR COLOMBIAN ARMY AVIATION STOCK.
