



Approach for Divisions, Brigades, Gendarmerie




Optimum Force Characteristics: Capable / readily available / self-sustaining / self-lifting / politically committed / ethnically and religiously diverse (Arab, Islamic...)

- **Near Term:**
 - Time is most critical -- meet urgent needs
 - Seek most capable / most deployable
 - Require no further political commitment or cover (No UNSCR)
 - Target Islamic country contributions-Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC)
 - Approach NOW with tailored requests by country
- **Mid Term:**
 - Approach all other capable countries with tailored requests
 - Target Asian and Latin American country contributions
 - Political constraints may impact immediate approach (UNSCR may be required)
- **Longer term:**
 - Seek those that require longer lead times to deploy / more defined political environment (UNSCR required)

*Immediate goal - Gain political commitment for large formations from countries not requiring a UN resolution
Simultaneously - As US pursues a UN resolution, seek planning commitment from countries requiring one*



Proposed Coalition Divisional Organizations




Long term goal is to establish a rotational process for coalition forces
