The following decisions were reached at a meeting of the Non-Proliferation PCC chaired by Assistant Secretary of State Richard A. Clarke on October 9, 1990. (U)

1. Line-in/line-out changes to the Enhanced Proliferation Control Initiative paper, for submission to a Deputies Committee, are due to AS Clarke by OOB, October 10.

2. A new section should be added to the EPCI paper, relating U.S. steps to multilateral measures. Commerce and DGE will provide language giving precedence to multilateral efforts. State, ACDA, OSD, and JCS will provide language giving precedence to unilateral efforts. These submissions should be coordinated and provided to AS Clarke by October 10. ~~(S)~~

3. State will request a Deputies Meeting to consider the EPCI, to be scheduled ASAP. ~~(S)~~


4. Dual-use list review.

(a) MTCR. Target dates to complete the following actions, as proposed in the Terms of Reference, were adopted: November 1 - Revisions to Export Administration Regulations; November 21 - Revised MTCR Annex, Alternate MTCR Annex. ~~(S)~~

(b) CBW. The working group will meet further to develop its list; State and Commerce will finalize terms of reference for its work ASAP. Target date for interagency approved CBW dual-use list is December 1, as per p. 2 of October 5 draft of EPCI paper. ~~(S)~~

~~(S)~~ Nuclear. State and Commerce are to draft and clear interagency a one-page summary describing the status of the revised Nuclear Referral List and State's proposed bilateral and multilateral discussions. This paper should be completed in time to attach it to the EPCI paper to be submitted to the Deputies Committee. ~~(S)~~

DAS Stratford is to set up a working group to resolve two related issues: (i) what furnaces to include on the NRL, and (ii) whether certain items from the 5000 series of the NRL should require an IVL to all countries. Failing resolution, the issues will be referred to the PCC. ~~(S)~~
