Police Assistance by Bloc Countries

Following information concerns assistance presently being provided to civil police forces of the countries indicated by Peoples Republic of China, the USSR and its satellites.

Peoples Republic of China

Tanzania - Weapons training (recently terminated and it is now believed this training is being given to "freedom fighter" personnel, such as FRELIMO (Mozambique), in the southern part of Tanganyika). Dar es Salaam, EMBAIR A-229, 12/7/65.

USSR

Ghana - Three advisors are presently providing technical assistance to the President's personal security organization. Accra, EMBAIR A-259, 11/26/65.

Guinea - Patrol boats were provided earlier this year and three technicians are providing training in presidential security. Conakry, EMBTEL 166, 8/23/65.

Jamaica - Assistance of unknown scope and character was offered to the Jamaican police recently. At this time this offer has not been accepted.

East Germany

Colombia - An offer to supply the police with a communications system, made earlier this year was turned down by the Colombians.

Tanzania - An unknown number of police are in training in East Germany.

Czechoslovakia

Guinea - Four technicians are providing security training to the Ministry of Defense and National Security. Conakry EMBTEL 166, 8/23/65 and EMBAIR A-10, 7/16/63.

Czechoslovakia (cont.)

Mali - The police assistance program terminated in 1964 is believed to be on the verge of being re-activated. Dimensions of this assistance are unknown. [REDACTED]

Yugoslavia OSD 3.3(b)(1) CIA 3.3(b)(1)

Ethiopia - Seven police officers are being trained in Yugoslavia in a five-year medical course and one in law. PSD Monthly Report for July 1965, TOAID A-199, 8/13/65.
