SUBJECT: Interagency Options Paper on Radio Broadcasting to Cuba

Enclosed please find a copy of the draft Interagency Options Paper on Radio Broadcasting to Cuba we discussed at the meeting of the IBC Radio Marti Committee on Friday morning, April 8, 1983. As agreed, I am forwarding it to you so that you can make changes you believe would improve the text as written and would provide amplifying material where is required. In addition, I would ask Lincoln Gordon to take the lead in developing a section VIII which addresses "The Impact of Possible Cuban Reprisal to US Reprisal Jamming Actions."

I will then incorporate your inputs into a new draft for consideration by the IBC Radio Marti Committee as well as amplify section V to explain all the Cuban radio services we considered as targets and why we rejected those involving safety to life. Please provide your changed drafts and new inputs to me by April 15 so I may work over the weekend on the new draft.
