

EGYPTIAN ITINERARY FOR SECDEF VISIT

Friday, 16 February 1979

- 1100 hrs: Arrive Luxor. Met at aircraft by Major General Ahmed Fakhr, Official Egyptian Ministry of Defense Escort Officer, and Mrs. Bahiga Fakhr; Brigadier General Cecil D. (Bud) Crabb, Chief of Office of Military Cooperation, and Mrs. Nancy Crabb. Several other Egyptian military officials of the area will also welcome the party.
- 1110 hrs: Depart airport by sedan and bus.
- 1130 hrs: Arrive ferry boat landing in front of Etap Hotel and board motor launch for crossing to West Bank of the Nile.
- 1140 hrs: Board sedan and bus for trip to Valley of the Kings, Hatshepsut Funerary Temple (Deir El Bahri), Funerary Temple of Ramses III (Medinat Habu), and other antiquities on the West Bank of the Nile. A light lunch will be served in conjunction with this tour.
