The following changes are recommended to the proposed DOD Directive, "Meteorological Satellite Communications (U)

Page 2, Paragraph IV, B, line 7

Change to read ".....be applied with due regard to the possibility of stimulating hostile action against U.S. satellite systems or of jeopardizing continued international cooperation in the exchange of meteorological data."

Reason: There may be situations in which the advantages of application may outweigh the potential disadvantages.

Page 3, Paragraph V, A, 2, line 2

Change to ".....systems and subsystems other than meteorological to which the"

Reason: Clarity

Page 3, Paragraph V, B, line 3

Change to ".....Department of State concurrence when necessary."

Reason: To conform to USCSB 3-12, paragraph 4, g.
