SUBJECT: U.S.-Korea Follow-On Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) (U)  
ACTION MEMORANDUM

(S) On 31 March 1982, at the 14th U.S.-Republic of Korea Security Consultative Meeting, you signed, along with ROK MND Choo, a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) establishing a mechanism to facilitate timely transfers of DOD stocks designated as War Reserve Stocks for Allies (WRSA) to Korea in a military emergency.

(C) The WRSA MOA contained a provision that the USG and ROKG would jointly study the applicability of the principles of the MOA to additional categories of items, other than WRSA, that would require special procedures to ensure prompt accomplishment of emergency wartime supply actions. As the result of this study, a follow-on MOA was developed covering emergency transfers of two additional categories of materiel: USG-owned stocks located in the ROK (other than WRSA) that COMUSKOREA may need to transfer to ROK forces to meet urgent tactical requirements, and materiel from CONUS and other offshore locations required to replace ROK combat losses and consumption during the first thirty days of hostilities.

(U) Recommend you sign the two original copies of the MOA attached at Tab A. The JCS (Tab B) and Department of State (Tab C) concur. As anticipated by paragraph 4.c. of the MOA, a certified duplicate Korean language text will be prepared and forwarded for your signature at a later date.
