2. I AM DELIGHTED THAT THE ARRANGEMENTS FOR YOUR VISIT TO KOREA ARE NOW FIRM, AND I AM LOOKING FORWARD TO WELCOMING YOU HERE. CENY AND I WOULD BE MOST PLEASED IF YOU AND MRS. WEINBERGER WOULD AGREE TO BE OUR GUESTS AT THE RESIDENCE. I THINK WE COULD OFFER YOU AN ESCAPE TO A CALMER ATMOSPHERE, AWAY FROM THE INEVITABLE PRESSURES OF THE VISIT.

3. WHETHER OR NOT YOU CAN STAY WITH US, WE WOULD LIKE TO HOST AN INFORMAL SUPPER FOR YOU ON THE EVENING OF YOUR ARRIVAL, MARCH 28. THE GUEST LIST WOULD BE SMALL AND LIMITED TO AMERICANS, AND THE SUPPER WOULD GIVE US AN OPPORTUNITY TO TALK BEFORE THE OFFICIAL ACTIVITIES BEGIN. IF THIS IDEA APPEALS TO YOU, IT WOULD BE HELPFUL IF WE COULD TELL THE KOREANS THAT YOU HAD REQUESTED SUCH A QUIET EVENING BEFORE BEGINNING YOUR OFFICIAL SCHEDULE ON THE 29TH. WALKER

WHILE IN THE AREA, SECDEF PLANS ALSO TO MEET WITH SENIOR U.S. AND FOREIGN OFFICIALS ON MATTERS OF MUTUAL INTEREST, AND VISIT U.S. FORCES AND MILITARY INSTALLATIONS. FOR USE IN PLANNING AND OBTAINING THEATER AND EMBASSY CLEARANCES, THE PROPOSED ITINERARY IS AS FOLLOWS:
