CONCURRENT CIA AND CENTCOM REVIEWS.

RAQ

1. **Summary:** No evidence of regional or national command and control behind attacks against Coalition forces. CJTF-7 conducted stability and support operations, continued DESERT SCORPION to eliminate non-compliant forces in conjunction with civil-military and humanitarian assistance missions, and facilitated the efforts of the CPA.
2. **Intelligence Overview:** Continued reporting, mostly HUMINT, of Ba'athist political activity and planned attacks against Coalition Forces throughout Iraq. Analysis of planned attacks over the past 30 days reveals little direct correlation between reported plans and observed actions.
 - a. **North:** Multiple HUMINT sources reported that "Return Party" Ba'athist resistance group planning attack on Ninawa Palace Hotel in Mosul on 21 or 22 June; 175 X US military headquartered in hotel.
 - b. **Baghdad:** Credible sources continued reporting imminent threat against Coalition forces and Iraqi civilians by Ansar al-Islam.
 - c. **Central:** Report of cooperation between Fedayeen Saddam, foreign Fedayeen, and local Iraqi tribesmen aligned to former regime planning to launch significant attacks against Coalition throughout Iraq in July.
 - d. **West:** NSTR.
 - e. **South:** NSTR.

Current Operations: Operation DESERT SCORPION continued: Coalition forces offensive combat operations against non-compliant forces and civil-military operations campaign to gain/maintain IZ popular support. Over the past 24 hours Coalition forces conducted 2150 patrols; guarded over 500 fixed sites; 16 X hostile engagements resulting in 1 X US KIA; 5 X US WIA; 1 X UK WIA; 3 X IZ WIA; 34 X IZ detained.

- I. Update on Baghdad Yellowcake: Continued clean-up work at the Tuwaitha facility; Team anticipates completion of clean-up 23 June and departure on 24 June.

AFGHANISTAN

1. **Intelligence Overview:** Anti-Coalition militants (ACM) continued attacks in southeastern Afghanistan near the Pakistani border. In the past week, nine rocket attacks occurred in the Khowst Province with no injuries or damage. Continued indications of anti-government elements implementing more sophisticated tactics, techniques and procedures to counter US / Coalition forces.
2. **Current Operations:** Operation UNIFIED RESOLVE: Pakistani forces block designated crossing points/routes of egress along the AFG/PAK border in Nangarhar and Konar provinces. Coalition positioning forces for assault phase.
