Mr. [REDACTED] stated he witnessed the soldier stand the naked detainee up and bend the detainee *b7c-4, 66-4* forward at the waist, at which time, Mr. [REDACTED] turned his head away in shame. Mr. [REDACTED] stated *b7c-4, 66-4* he could hear the other detainee screaming curse words at the guard. Mr. [REDACTED] stated he did not know who the other detainee was, nor could he give any further description of the people involved or the specific events that occurred. *b7c-4, 66-4*

This statement is being prepared by Special Agent [redacted] and was translated by [redacted] on behalf of Mr. [redacted]

I was captured on 21 or 22 December 2003 at my house in Baghdad, Iraq. I was transported in a vehicle, which may have been a Humvee, to an unknown location at Baghdad International Airport, Baghdad, IZ, which was formerly known as Saddam Airport. When I was first taken into the building, there were three people in civilian clothes and an Egyptian interpreter there. They took pictures of me and conducted a medical examination. I was then taken to another room where I was cuffed on the legs and hands. I was then taken to a third room. When my feet were restrained and hung from the wall. My upper back was then placed on a cardboard box. Loud music, like heavy metal music, was being played. He was beaten for about ten minutes by an unknown person. A medic then came to the room to treat his wounds. Prior to this, he was hooded with a cloth bag. The medic removed the bag. I then observed that the room was dark, but the lights were then turned on. The medic was a short, fat, black, female soldier. She was wearing DCU pants and a brown T-shirt. The female medic, through the air Lebanese interpreter said, "who did this to you?" I replied "I don't know." The medic left and the bag was placed over his head again. Water was then dripped onto the bag over my face, making it difficult to breathe. My ears were also filled with water. An unknown person then straddled my chest and sat on me. This person then began striking me

on the neck with what felt like empty water bombs. This caused my neck to swell. This abuse continued for twelve hours, after which another group of people came in and punched me in the eyes, kidneys, and chest. I was also kicked in the chest. I think they did this because I told them I had medical problems with my eyes, kidneys, and heart. They picked me up by my wrist and took pictures. I know ⁷⁶⁻⁴¹⁶⁶⁴ they took pictures because I could see the flash. One of the people who abused me was a very tall man, very muscular, with blonde hair and blue eyes. This man wore civilian clothing and said he was from the southern United States. He was called "[REDACTED]" ^{67C-556-5} When I asked him why he was doing this and called him "[REDACTED]" ^{67C-556-5} he acted surprised and asked how I knew that name. Also, an Asian female, medium build, with her hair in a ponytail came into the room and struck me in the genitals with a chemical light. She then poured the contents of the chemical light on his genitals. While I was hooded, two unknown people held my legs apart while an unknown person struck my genitals with a stick, similar to an antenna. The Egyptian interpreter wore a military uniform, was very thin and lightly tanned. He had curly black hair and no facial hair. The Lebanese interpreter was shorter than I am and middle-sized. He wore eyeglasses and had blonde hair, but no facial hair. I did not see any tattoos on any of them. I was forced to write a statement about IED attacks. At first I refused, and they tied me up and put me on my stomach. Another detainee was in the room and was tied up in the same manner. A black soldier entered the room and started to rape the other detainee. I turned my head away when I saw this. I was then told to sign the statement or the same thing would happen to me. ^{67C-556-5} [REDACTED] told me what to write and I made the statement. After I signed the statement, they gave my clothes back and the doctor who first checked me, he was a white male, came back and gave me medicine for my heart. The next day I was taken to Abu Ghraib by helicopter. I was held for about 15 days at Baghdad Airport. When I left I was in very bad health. I have been treated well since I left [REDACTED]


